Bible portion : 1 Kings 17: 1-16

Memory Verse : Psalms 147: 9

Objective : Those who strengthen themselves by strong faith in God. He shall care for them

even in famine.

Teaching Aids : Pictures of:

King and Queen; whole country is under severe drought; Elijah hiding near a brook; Elijah conveys God's oracle to the king

Introduction : Agriculture is an important aspect of our life. In order to do agriculture well, there should be rain in proper times. If there is no rain when required, it would be difficult for us to live. If it is not possible for us to do agriculture, we would suffer famine. Not only that but all of us will die without any water to drink. Have you not seen wells and streams dry up during summer? Then, it becomes necessary to bring water from faraway places.
