Reading Portion: Exodus chapters 15 and 17

The people of Israel crossed the Red sea and entered the wilderness. The pillar of clouds in the morning and the pillar of fire at night confirmed and revealed the presence of God with them. They suffered the heat, dust, thirst, hunger and tiredness of the wilderness. They used to rest where there was water. But when there is not enough food or water, they used to murmur and complain to Moses. In their journey, they had scarcity of water. There were no wells or lakes, their water vessels were empty. Their children cried out of thirst and mothers were helpless. Three days they travelled without water and the people became so weak. Moses strengthened them. And then they heard the ones in front shouting aloud 'water, water'. Everyone rushed to drink water and they drank eagerly. But what a pity! They spat out the water as it


was bitter. Children started to cry again. Then Moses prayed to God. God showed him a tree. He broke a piece of wood and threw it into the water. Oh what a miracle! They continued their journey and there was no more food. They again grumbled to Moses. Moses told all their needs to God. That evening, God send a wind and large amount of quail came and covered the camp. As per Moses instructions, they caught the quails and prepared food. Thus according to their desires, they got lot of meat and they ate contently. The next day morning, when the children woke up and came outside their tent, they saw thin flakes like frost on the ground. They picked it and tasted it. It tasted sweet like honey. They called it 'Manna'. Then Moses said to them, "It is the bread the Lord has given you to eat. Each one can gather as much as he wants for each day. The day before Sabbath, collect double than usual days." Further in their journey, God delivered them from their enemies and from other dangers. God provided them all their timely needs. They thanked and praised God for all his blessings.



Message: Praise God when we receive blessings from God. Do not grumble when our blessings are delayed. God will give us our needs at the right time
