DISOBEDIENCE OF ADAM

Bible portion : Genesis: 3: 1- 24

Memory Verse : proverbs 3:1

Objective : We must obey God wholeheartedly

Teaching Aids : Pictures of:

- a) Eve looking at forbidden fruit and Satan, in the form of a snake, talking to her
- b) Adam and Eve standing disappointed, as they were driven out of the garden.
- c) Cherubim's were placed at the gate of the garden with a flaming sword.
- d) Aprons made of fig leaves sewn together.
- e) And other teaching aids and notes

Introduction : A shepherd had many sheep and he used to drive them into pen in the evening to protect them from wild animals. But a lamb of the flock did not enter into the pen and hid itself outside. In the moonlight it frolicked outside. At that time a jackal which came preying, noticed the lamb. It came running and pounced upon the lamb, killed it and ate. The lamb suffered death as a result of disobedience. Likewise, the punishment that Adam and Eve suffered is what we shall learn today.
